Townsend Recycling Center is now accepting CLEAN Styrofoam for recycling, including the following:

- Packing Peanuts
- Electronics packaging
- Food trays (**MUST BE CLEAN**)
- Any CLEAN Styrofoam that is NOT stretchy

Bags are available at the Center for use at home for those who have large quantities - fill the bags and bring them in to drop off.

For smaller quantities, we have containers at the Center for drop-offs.

MANAGING HAZARDOUS PRODUCTS

- Look for eco-friendly products.
- Read labels carefully & store safely.
- Use products according to directions.
- Use or share products you have.

FEEES FOR DISPOSAL

CASH IS PREFERRED FORM OF PAYMENT

Residents:

- \$40 for up to 10 gal / 10lbs of material
- \$60 for up to 25 gal / 25lbs of material

Businesses:

- Must pre-register; can not service small or large quantity generator (SQG, LQG firms).
- Fees depend on products & volume.

HOW TO TRANSPORT SAFELY

- Keep materials in original containers.
- Tighten caps and lids.
- Sort by type.
- Pack in sturdy upright boxes and pad with newspaper.
- Never smoke while handling hazardous materials.
- Do not transport more than 55 gallons per trip.
- **NEVER MIX CHEMICALS**

From Ayer Traffic Circle:

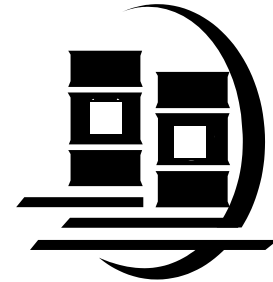

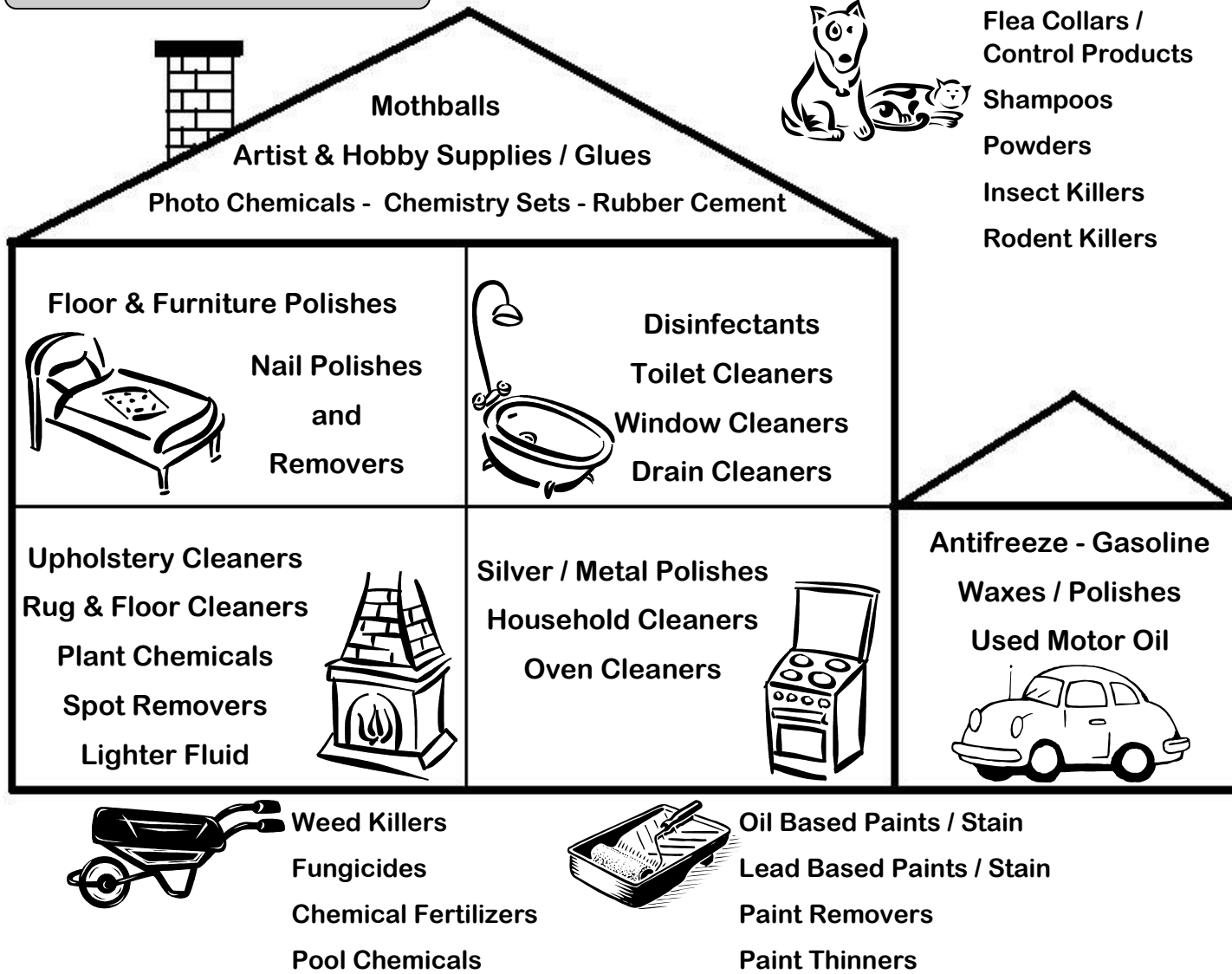

WHAT TO BRING



OTHER ITEMS ACCEPTED

(fees may apply)

- Batteries - automotive and industrial lead acid
- Batteries - rechargeable & button
- Bubble wrap, packing peanuts
- Fluorescent bulbs
- Latex Paint - Can be treated as regular trash after dried.
- Mercury thermometers
- Printer ink and toner cartridges
- Thermostats

WHAT NOT TO BRING

Items to be put in your regular trash:

- Alkaline Batteries
- Empty Aerosol Cans
- Empty Containers
- Infectious / Biological Wastes
- Prescription medicines
- Smoke Detectors

Check with your local trash facility or Board of Health:

- Asbestos
- Bulky / Non-Hazardous Items
- Commercial / Industrial Waste
- Compressed Gas Cylinders
- Construction Materials
- Fire Extinguishers
- Needles / Syringes
- Propane, Butane, Other Flammable Gas
- Radioactive Waste
- Tires / PCB's
- White Goods

Call your local Police Department:

- Ammunition, fireworks, explosives
