CO-VID Update: The State will be coming out with weekly numbers later today. 2/4 numbers showed 30 active cases and the town is still in the Red category. Mass vaccination sites have opened for adults over 75 years of age and their companions, regardless of age. The 211 number has been helping coordinate the appointments. Pharmacy and Doctor offices as well as two Leominster Hannaford's and the Leominster Hospital should be opening with vaccinations in the future. The Nashoba Board of Health still have very limited quantities and continues to work with the Council on Aging to determine where the doses will go in Townsend.

478 Main Street: Septic has failed. No variances are required. A MOTION was made by GB and 2nd by JL to approve the septic upgrade. Voting 2/0 MOTION passes.

36 Old Battery Road: Septic has failed. No variances are required. A MOTION was made by GB and 2nd by JL to approve the septic upgrade. Voting 2/0 MOTION passes.
