Meeting Business: Discussion of FY23 ATM Budget and ATM Warrant

Review of ATM Budget:

Ross Perry, interim Town Administrator, reviewed the updated Recap Sheet. The town needs ~\$50,786 K to balance the budget. Need to make a decision on how to proceed at Town Meeting re: funds from free cash or stabilization.

Ross has been advised that the School Committee is meeting this evening and is considering a lower assessment number. If we get the lower number, what is our process and direction to Ross?

If the School Committee comes back with a lower assessment number:

- 1. Restore 3% increase for all employees
- 2. Restore all streetlights
- 3. Restore public safety salaries so they are not funded from ARPA. Take one position for police out of ARPA first.

Reviewing changes in FY23 Budget:

Motion was made by Theresa Morse and seconded by Chaz Sexton-Diranian to accept the figure of 1,679,133 for General Government.

Vote was unanimous - all in favor.
