2.1 8:15pm Continuation of Notice of Intent DEP#308- 662

Applicant: Locke Brooke Solar, LLC Location: 22 West Meadow Road

Project: The proposed project is for the development of a ground-mounted solar photovoltaic energy system. Project is located within in the riverfront area, ACEC and ORW.

Thadeous Soule (TS) was present for Locke Brook Solar. DEP had numerous comments, many were concerns brought up by the Commission at the last meeting. TS addressed all the questions and concerns from DEP and the Commission. MT was concerned with the use of the hayfield. The habitat in the hayfield is important and may be compromised. He would like an assessment of the habitat in the area. There is more than 5,000 square feet of field habitat that needs to be assessed and think of ways to enhance habitat quality. Are there temporary sediment basins for the SWPPP? As there will be more than an acre of exposure there will need to be an additional row of wattles.

KH moves to continue the hearing to 12-12-18 at 7:45pm. JH seconded. All in favor.

2.2 Stan Dillis - Scales Lane

Stan Dillis was present for 40 Scales Lane. He would like to request a partial Certificate of Compliance as one was never requested.
