Project: The proposed project is for the replacement of a septic system located within the buffer of a wetland and the ACEC.

Replacement will be a presby design. There are no other locations for the septic. Wattles will be installed and inspected by the agent prior to the start of work.

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3.3 Discuss and review the Wetland Regulations – MT would like to see waivers for the 25'. We will look at the benefits, if any, of having an extra 25' buffer for vernal pools. KH would like to see colored buffers on all submitted applications. We will change the application requirements as regulations call for seven copies. Two copies and an electronic version are sufficient.

3.4 Discuss treatment of invasive species- KH went to an Ayer Conservation Commission meeting for a discussion on treatment of invasive species in a few bodies of water. The town has spent a proximately \$60,000 on treatment in a single year. The treatment has been successful, however, it has to be maintained. KH inquired as to how the initiative began. The people of Ayer wanted treatments conducted to stop the spread of the invasive species. KH would like for the commission to sponsor someone from the highway department in obtaining an applicators license.
