## JANUARY 23, 2019, 7:00 PM TOWNSEND ENERGY COMMITTEE MINUTES

- Call the Meeting to Order: Brent Carney (BC) called the meeting to order at 7:10 p.m. Mike Brown (MB), Ron Montgomery (RM), and Kathy Thompson (KT) were in attendance.
- **Approval of Meeting Minutes from 12/19/18:** Motion to accept minutes by RM, second by KT. All voted in favor
- Public Forum: None
- **Update on Green Community Grants:** General discussion on the progress and meetings to complete the 4 projects.
- **Discussion regarding LED streetlight upgrades project:** General discussion regarding the completion of the streetlight project. KT indicated a Townsend Police officer informed her that the light in front of the police station had not been changed over. BC indicated he would reach out to Unitil regarding this.

- Discussion of 2020 competative grant application: KT will research
  previous bylaws for purchasing vehicles. Possible projects town common.
  Vehicle purchases. RM wants to discuss the role for the committee after we run
  out of grant fund projects. Brent suggests asking town or John H. to help find
  projects.
